
BizTalk Server Business Rules Engine (BRE) is a run-time inference engine that evaluates rules against facts and initiates actions based on the results of that evaluation.

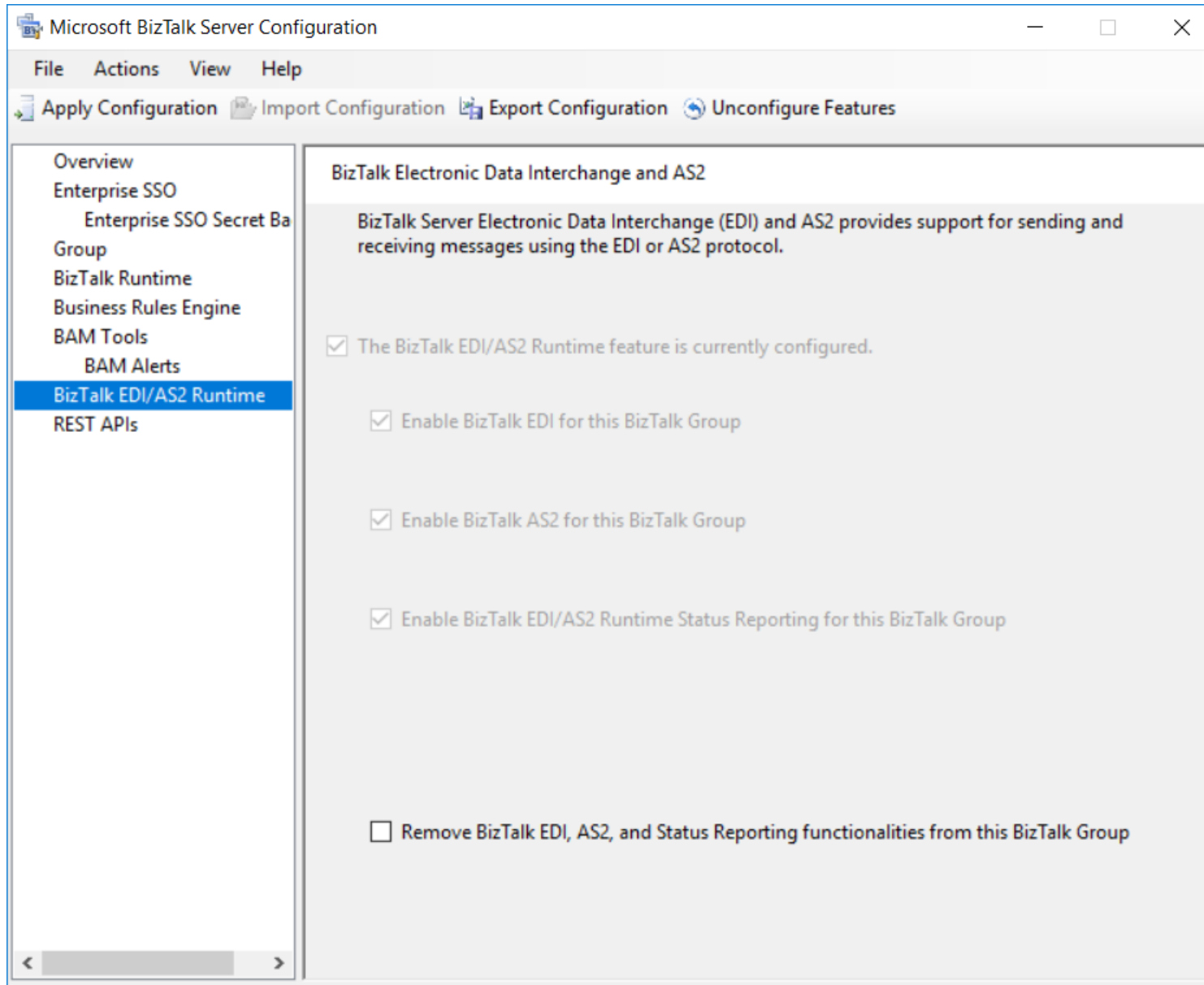
